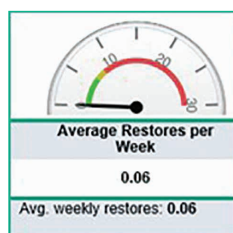
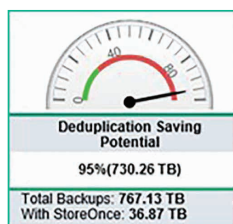
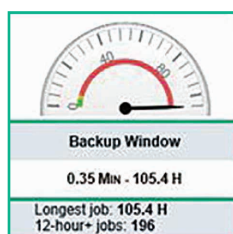

- If the guarantee is not met, Hewlett Packard Enterprise will make up the difference with additional capacity and support

## GPG program requirements

- Complete the NinjaProtected assessment to determine if you qualify for the GPG
- Backup applications supported: HPE Data Protector or Veritas NetBackup
- Customer must perform daily and weekly full backups to qualify for the 95 percent guarantee<sup>1</sup>
- Customer must retain their stored data for a minimum of 90 days
- Customer data may not be encrypted or pre-compressed
- Only specific data types are applicable for GPG; see the **“Terms and Conditions”** for details
