Installation

Note: Make sure all devices you are connecting are powered off prior to installation.

- 1.** Connect an HDMI cable between the HDMI port on the adapter unit and an HDMI source.
- 2.** Connect the VGA male end of the adapter unit to the VGA display.
- 3.** Connect a 3.5 mm audio cable between the 3.5 mm port on the unit and the audio jack on your monitor or speakers.
- 4.** Turn on the power to the connected devices. If you are not receiving a signal after powering up, connect a USB cable between the Micro-B port on the unit and the USB-A port on a USB charger or the HDMI source.
