About Installation

To protect your projector and to be sure that no damage occurs please install in a dry well ventilated area.

Do not place projector in direct sunlight.

Projector environment operating temperature should exceed or go below 32 to 158 degrees F

Do not block the ventilation-window of projector. If the projector's internal temperature gets to hot, the projector will shut off automatically. Please be sure to clean the air filter regularly. Do not allow dust to build upon the filter. About Powering On

When powering on the projector, connect the power cable and be sure it is plugged into the correct 3 prong AC voltage outlet. Press the power button on the top of the unit. The projector will power on, but the lamp will slowly grow brighter with time. After 5 minutes the lamp will be at normal brightness.

When turning off the projector, press the power button again. The lamp will shut off. The internal fans will remain running for an additional 5 minutes to continue cooling the internal electronic components and lamp. When turning of the projector to not unplug the power cable directly. After five minutes the projector will finish cooling and shut of automatically.

Warning:

The fans on this unit adjust the internal temperature. The fans will change speed as the internal temperature of the unit changes. The fan motor noise will fluctuate as well, this is normal operation. Please do not pull power cable while the projector is operation. If the fans lose power before the internal temperature of the unit cools, this may cause damage to the internal components.





The projector is so easy to use as the TV. While some problems my occur because of the environment and voltage. Please try to recognize the fake malfunction before refer to the technicians



1 when the power, switch is tuned on the indicator light does not work	The power is not connected wellThe power switch fuse is burnedCheck the over-heat protection system
2. The remote control can not turn on projector	 The power switch turn on or off? The remote control battery is depleted? Something is standing between the remote and IR Strong light on IR directly
3. No image on the screen	 Is the channel set-up correct? Is there an input signal? Is the input cable plugged in well? Under PC model ,is the refresh rate >75KHz? When the projector is connected with the notebook, set the screen as VGA mode

- 1. Using the projector, press "menu". The picture display on screen to adjust menu(picture I)
- 2. Press " ◀/▶" key, the menu in turn circle into "picture" > "sound"> "time" > "system"
- 3. Select the adjust interface, use "▲/▼" key to choose the wanted item (picture II)
- 4. Press "OK" or "◀/▶" to adjust the item parameter.
- 5. Finished the elected item parameter, press the "menu"key again, exit the page
- 6. Repeat operating step $2\sim5$, till you finished all the parameters, press "exit" exit the menu page, otherwise, the menu page will auto exit after a period time

When you use the projector for the first time .It normally will appear image faintness or the image is trapezoid. This is caused by the wrong lens focus or trapezoid correction Please follow the below steps to correct:

Focus adjustment


1. Rotate the lens into projector, the rotate it out slowly. At the same time, looking at the resolution point carefully. When the image is clear, it is the best situation of the lens







Keystone

1. If a projected picture has keystone distortion, correct image with Keystone adjustment. The image becomes trapezoid shape when the screen or projector is not leveled. Please reposition the projector to improve its angle to the screen. However, the circumference of the image may not be focused









Remote control

If the projector is a new one, please read the "projector install chapter, place the projector and connect the cables," follow the below steps to turn on/off

Turn on

- 1. Put in two 7-size battery in the remote control before using
- 2. Pull the power switch on the backboard as the power light turn red







- **4.** The lamp start working 2 seconds later, image projected on the screen the machine is working smoothly
- 5. The new projector may have problems like image unclear or trapezoid distortion, Please read "image adjustment" chapter
- 6. After the image is clear ,you may enjoy the program, in the meantime ,you can still setup the system or adjust the parameters








