- 4. Press the NEXT / BACK button or 10(+) to select the song to be programmed.
- 5. To start program play by pressing PLAY button.
- To stop program play, press STOP button on main unit or on remote control. During setting
  the program play, you can press Program/Memory button on main unit or MEMORY key on
  remote control to cancel.

#### MP3/CD PLAYBACK

- 1. Slide the CD/USB Button(11) switch to CD/MP3 mode.

When playing the MP3 files or WMA files in the device, the operation is the same with the MP3 operation described above.




