



POWER & BATTERY

Plug the power cord into a standard AC power outlet to power the unit. This unit requires 6 C-size, batteries (not included) for battery power.





BLUETOOTH SETUP

Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

- Press the Source button to switch to Bluetooth Mode. "bt" will flash on the display.
- 2. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.
- 3. If the unit does not automatically begin to pair, press the **Pair** button.
- Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the IBC233 in your Bluetooth settings to pair.
- 5. If your device requests a password, enter the default password **0000**.
- Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices. When successfully paired, the display will stop flashing.
- After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.
- 8. If your device should become unpaired, follow the above steps again.
- If any pairing issues should occur, un-pair the unit on your Bluetooth device and follow the above steps again.

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- To select, play, pause or skip a track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device, or press the Pair/Play/Pause or Tun/ Skip/Search buttons.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

CD

Note: This unit is not compatible with MP3 CDs.

Loading and Playing a CD

- Open the CD door and place a CD in the boombox, label side facing up.
- Close the CD door.
- 3. Press the **Source** button to select CD mode.
- Press the Play/Pause button to begin playing the loaded disc.

Programming a CD

- 1. Press the **Prog/Mem** button.
- Press the Tun/Skip/Search buttons to select a track.
- 3. Press the **Prog/Mem** button to save the track to the program.
- Repeat step 2 and 3 until the desired number of CD tracks are programmed.
- 5. Press the **Play** button to begin playing the program.

LINE IN

Using the Line In

3.5 mm audio input cable not included.

- Plug one end of a 3.5 mm audio input cable into the Line In input on the back of the unit, and plug the other end of the cable into the audio output on an MP3 Player or other audio source.
- 2. Press the **Power** button to power the unit on.
- 3. Press the **Source** button to select **Line In** mode.
- Audio played through the connected device will now be heard through the speakers.

RADIO

Tuning the FM Radio

This unit is equipped with an internal FM radio antenna. To improve radio reception, adjust the position of the boombox.

- Press the **Source** button to switch to **FM Radio** mode.
- Press the Tun/Skip/Search buttons to tune the radio manually, press and hold to search for the next available station.

Saving a Station as a Preset

- Press the Prog/Mem button.
- 2. Press the **Tun/Skip/Search** to select a preset number. Up to 20 stations may be preset.
- Press the **Mem** button to save the current station to the selected preset.
- Press the Preset-/Repeat and Preset+/Stop buttons to cycle through saved presets.
