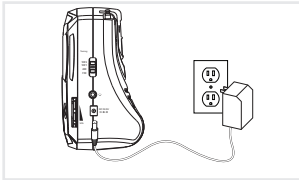

Introduction and Setup

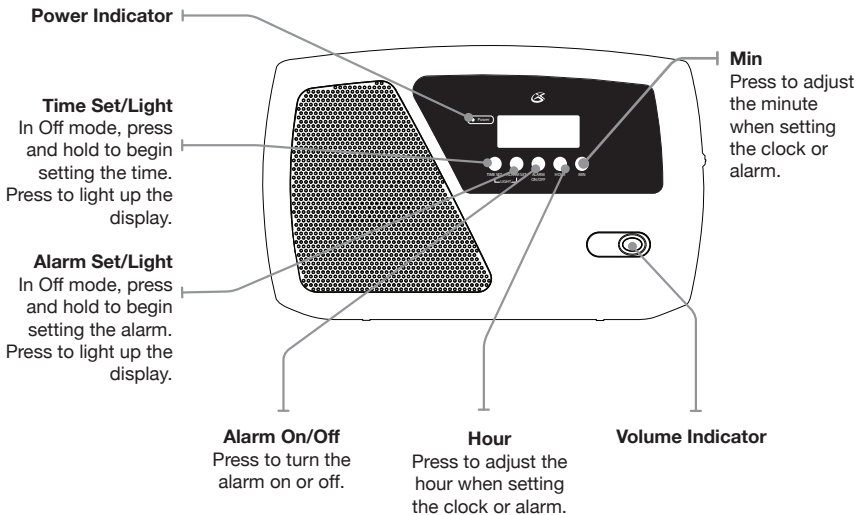
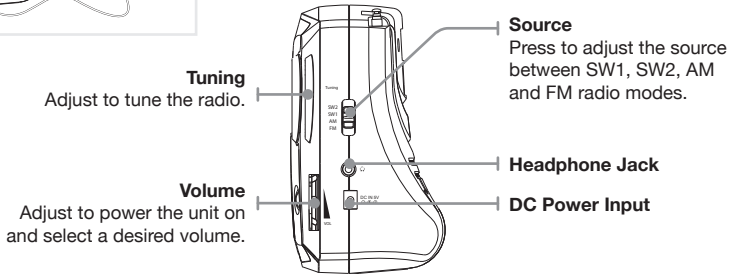
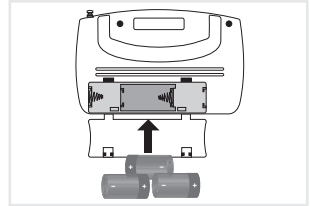
Power

Plug the AC power cord into an AC power outlet to power the dock.



Battery Backup

Requires 3, D-size, batteries (not included)



Clock and Sleep Timer

Setting the Clock

1. If in radio mode, turn the volume to Off to turn the unit off.
2. Press and hold the **Time Set** button and while holding it down, press the **Hour** button to adjust the hour.

The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.

3. Release the **Hour** button.
4. Press and hold the **Time Set** button and while holding it down, press the **Min** button to adjust the hour.
5. Release the **Time Set** button to finish setting the time.

Alarm

Setting the Alarm

1. If in radio mode, turn the volume to Off to turn the unit off.
2. Press and hold the **Alarm Set** button and while holding it down, press the **Hour** button to adjust the hour.

The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.

3. Release the **Hour** button.
4. Press and hold the **Alarm Set** button and while holding it down, press the **Min** button to adjust the hour.
5. Release the **Alarm Set** button to finish setting the time.

Turning the Alarm On and Off

1. Follow the instructions for [Setting the Alarm](#).
2. Press the **Alarm On/Off** button repeatedly.

Radio

Tuning the AM or FM Radio

1. Turn the volume dial to the desired level to turn the radio on.
2. Adjust the **Source** switch to AM or FM as desired.
3. Adjust the tuning dial to tune to the desired frequency.

Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the **FM Antenna** to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the clock radio. To improve AM radio reception, adjust the position of the clock radio.

Tuning the Shortwave Radio

1. Turn the volume dial to the desired level to turn the radio on.
2. Adjust the **Source** switch to SW1 or SW2 as desired.
3. Adjust the tuning dial to search through any available frequencies.

Note: It is typical for reception to be poor or spotty.

4. It is high recommended to use the radio at night, as more frequencies will be available.
