Setting up your phone

Your phone already has a SIM card installed.

REMOVE SIM/microSD TRAY

Use the SIM card tray removal tool to open the SIM/microSD card tray.

CHARGE YOUR DEVICE

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully.

INSERT microSD CARD

Insert the microSD card (microSD card sold separately) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down.

NOTE: Use only Samsung approved charging devices and accessories. Samsung accessories are designed for your device to maximize battery life. Using other accessories may void your warranty and may cause damage.

Using your phone

Turning your phone on/off

To turn your phone on, press and hold the **Power/Lock** button.

To turn your phone off, press and hold the **Power/Lock** button. Then tap **Power off** > **Power off**.

Locking/Unlocking the screen

To unlock your screen, press the **Power/Lock** button and then swipe up.

> To set a screen lock feature, from the Home screen, swipe up and then tap **Settings** > **Lock screen** and choose your screen lock type. Then follow the onscreen instructions.

NOTE: For added security, choose a Biometric locking feature.

Copying content from your old phone

For help transferring contacts, photos and other content from your old phone, visit verizonwireless.com/Cloud.

Or, transfer content using Smart Switch and the USB connector that came with your phone.

> From the Home screen, swipe up and then tap **Settings** > **Accounts** > **Smart Switch**.

Home screen mode

You can select one of the two modes: Easy or Standard. Instructions in this guide are written using Standard mode.

Standard mode is for users who are familiar with Android™.

Easy mode is a simplified experience for the first-time smartphone user.

- > From the Home screen, swipe up and then tap **Settings** > **Display** > **Easy mode**.
- Choose the mode you want to use and tap **DONE**.



Using your phone

S Pen with Bluetooth

UNLEASH THE PEN

Push the **S Pen** inward and, then pull it out.

When you remove the S Pen, Air command launches.

S PEN BUTTON

Press and hold the S Pen button to open an app remotely.

A single or double press can open an app, capture a photo, navigate, scroll and more.

Remove the S Pen, and tap **Settings** > **S Pen remote** to set the S Pen remote features.



There's no limit to the S Pen

Express yourself. Write and draw directly into emails or the calendar, as well as Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and PDF documents. Capture your ideas in Notes and even write a note on the back of a picture.

Air Command

Air command gives you access to signature S Pen features.

Create note: Create customized notes.

View all notevs: View all notes created.

Smart select: Outline and crop anything on the screen and freely edit or share with others.


Screen write: Capture a screen image and write or draw on it.

Live message: Create live messages and GIFs.

Translate: Hover the S Pen over a word to view its definition and pronunciation.

PENUP: Use the S Pen to draw, color, edit, and share live drawings.

Add shortcuts: Select an app or function to open or turn on using Air command.

Swipe left or right to select a mode.

BIXBY VISION

Identify objects or locations.

TOOLS PANEL


Swipe left or right to select effects.

Super slow-mo captures several frames per second, slowing down reality so you can enjoy every frame.


AR EMOJI
